



CLIMBING IRONS



Sahlins climbing irons have been designed and built using the latest knowledge of both ergonomics and engineering expertise. Full consultation with accredited experts has been undertaken to ensure that the ultimate in design has been achieved this has helped to avoid friction loadings on the human frame particularly on the knees, hips and back.

The design has achieved this reduction by studying the standing position and then recreating it and thereby producing a natural standing position for both the legs and the feet and where movement does not produce excess loadings.

The climbing irons are made of steel with a nitrocarburated and saltbathoxidated surface for improved corrosion and fatigue resistance.

All teeth and straps are easily replaceable.
